Fitting Guide - Hazard Treads

- 1. Ensure surface on which Anti-Slip Hazard Treads will be applied is clean, dry and free from loose or peeling materials.
- 2. Apply a thin coat of Anti Slip Floor Primer to the area where Anti-Slip Hazard Treads will be placed and allow to dry fully.
- 3. Space individual pieces a minimum of ½" and a maximum of 2" apart. Position ½" from stair edges
- 4. Round the corners of any pieces cut from rolls.
- 5. Peel protective liner back about 2" from one end and position piece on surface. IMPORTANT: Minimize touching adhesive with fingers.
- 6. Continue to remove liner while firmly pressing exposed Anti-Slip Hazard Treads into place.
- 7. Press into firm contact with surface using a rubber hand roller by starting in the middle and rolling out to edges.
- 8. Use Floor Tape Edge Sealer to ensure greater adhesion and longer product life.
